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GETTING STARTED

Welcome to Newlane University! This guide is designed to empower you to manage your academic journey with confidence. Use this guide to understand your course requirements, track your progress, and plan your courses, all while keeping everything simple and organized. This guide answers the following questions:

- What courses are required for your desired degree?
- Which courses satisfy each category requirement?
- How can I take charge of my academic success?

KEY TERMS TO KNOW

Corequisite: A course or requirement that you **must take at the same time** as another course.

- *Example: Exploring the Liberal Arts* may be taken as a corequisite alongside the *Foundations of Natural Science* course. Jane wants to take *Foundations of Natural Science*; however, Jane has not yet completed the *Exploring the Liberal Arts* course. To take *Foundations of Natural Science*, Jane must enroll in **both** *Exploring the Liberal Arts* and *Foundations of Natural Science* **at the same time**.

Prerequisite: A course or requirement that you **must complete before** you can take another course.

- *Example: Introduction to Philosophy* may be taken as a prerequisite for the *Advanced Topics: Metaphysics* course. Sam is very interested in taking *Advanced Topics: Metaphysics*. Sam must pass *Introduction to Philosophy* **before** he can take *Advanced: Metaphysics*.

Milestone: A significant step or group of related academic requirements students must complete as part of their degree program.

- *Example: Amir* needs to complete all 4 degree milestones to earn his Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Arts degree. Amir decides to spend the first year of his enrollment systematically completing all of the required general education courses. At the conclusion of the Amir's first year, Amir will have completed Milestone 1 (General Education).

UNDERSTANDING THE DEGREE COMPLETION MILESTONES

Earning your Bachelor of Arts degree at Newlane University is clear and achievable. By achieving four simple milestones, you can independently and confidently earn your degree.

MILESTONE 1: Complete All General Education Course Requirements

- Build foundational skills in communication, mathematics, scientific reasoning, and the humanities.

MILESTONE 2: Complete All Major or Core Requirements

- Establish and strengthen your understanding of key concepts of your chosen discipline.

MILESTONE 3: Complete All Specialization or Advanced Requirements

- Dive deeper into your chosen field of study.

MILESTONE 4: Complete Any Electives (If Applicable)

- Expand your learning and personalize your degree by selecting courses that align with your interests and goals.

Reminder: Newlane students can complete these milestones in any order based on their academic plan and availability.

USING THE DEGREE COMPLETION GUIDE

To get the most out of the Degree Completion Guide, it is essential to understand how to use it effectively. Here are a few recommendations to consider before you begin:

- ✓ **Review Program Requirements:** Understand what is required for each milestone.
- ✓ **Track Your Progress:** Check the box (☑) next to each completed course and category, ensuring you meet the required credits for each category.
- ✓ **Pay Attention to Symbols:** The guide sometimes lists symbols (such as + or ★) beside courses. Be sure to pay close attention to these symbols when selecting courses, as they represent considerations that may help you make strategic course choices.
 - *Example:* Bao needs to complete one (1) more Scientific Reasoning course to satisfy Milestone 1; however, his ultimate goal is to earn his Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Arts degree. He notices *NATSCI201: Foundations of Natural Science* has a + symbol, meaning it also counts toward Milestone 2. Instead of taking a different Scientific Reasoning course, Bao chooses *NATSCI201* so he can satisfy two milestones at once.
- ✓ **Apply Transfer Credits (if applicable):** If you have approved transfer credits, update the corresponding "TXFR" row for the given category and mark the course as complete.
- ✓ **Manage Your Electives:** Choose electives that fit your academic and professional goals, and record and track completed electives in the designated section.
- ✓ **Update Personal Notes:** Use the "Personal Notes" area to plan your next milestones, track milestones, and save advisor recommendations.
- ✓ **Take Ownership of Your Path:** While the Student Support Team is always available to support you, this guide lets you plan and manage your academic progress confidently. You have the tools to lead your own journey!
